



# Lake Lenape Alcohol Policy

To all Lake Lenape Members and Attending Guests

As decided at the board meeting on June 25th 2013, we will be enacting an Alcohol Policy for all lake events moving forward effective immediately. This policy is intended to prevent issues of underage drinking at the lake and will govern how alcohol served at all future the lake events. The bi-laws and rules will continue to govern personal consumption of alcohol which remain unchanged.

There are three major changes to the way alcohol will be handled at lake events:

1. All Lake provided alcohol will be kept in a defined space near the club house - this will be similar to how events were handled in the past, however, no alcohol should be stored in the clubhouse or other areas of the property or left unattended.
  2. Anyone consuming alcohol provided by the lake association will need to wear a bracelet provided by the association, and anyone who appears to be under the age of 21 will need to provide a driver's license or state id to prove they are over 21. Validity of the ID is at the discretion of the appointed person checking the IDs.
  3. A designated person (or persons) will be responsible for monitoring alcohol access. A bracelet will be issued to individuals who produce proper (legal) identification proving they are age 21 or over. In addition to the assigned monitor(s), any board member may act in the capacity of monitor to dispense or revoke bracelets.

For any event where there is the possibility that the Alcohol defined location cannot be monitored, the taps will be removed from the kegs and the wine collected and stored in the locked fridge until such time where they can be properly monitored again.

Any parents who voluntarily allow their children, under the age of 21, to consume alcohol (personal or lake provided) are subject to the laws of the state of NJ and the rules of the association. All lake members are asked to remain observant and to report any underage drinking to a member of the board immediately.
