



Lake Lenape Wireless Internet Service

Services – Usage Policy and Guidelines – Restrictions

Lake Lenape is pleased to offer Wireless internet access to its members. Make the lake your office for the day and enjoy the ability to “work remotely” while relaxing on the beach. The clubhouse has been outfitted with a wireless access point which allows contributing members to access the internet.

The Internet services are NOT part of the general Lake funds and must be paid for entirely by member contributions. Therefore, **only those that contribute will be allowed to utilize the internet service**. All time, hardware and management for this project has been donated in order to reduce the cost as much as possible.

The fee for the season is \$25 (per family) which must be paid in full before you are allowed to connect to the internet. Please contact a Board Member if you wish to use this service or to make a payment.

Services:

- The Internet subscription is provided by Service Electric via a Cable Modem. The current service supports speeds up to 8 meg. The actual speeds may vary based on the number of connected members as well as peak usage times.
- Internet services will be available from approximately May 29th until September 29th after which time they will be de-activated in order to keep the subscription cost as low as possible.
- Internet connection is via Wireless (Wi-Fi) ONLY and can be accessed via Laptop, Smartphone, Tablet or handheld gaming console.
- Wireless connection speeds will vary by device and distance from the Access Point located within the clubhouse.
- All connected devices will be protected by a firewall and content filter.
- Common services such as VPN, Facebook, Pandora, Skype and Netflix are permitted and encouraged.
- Connection to the Wi-Fi is not guaranteed, but we will work as hard as possible to maintain the equipment and service for your use.
- The Lake Lenape Association cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred to your device physically or electronically while using the internet or having your device on Association property.

Usage Policy and Guidelines:

- Internet access is for contributing lake members only.
- Access passwords are not to be shared outside of the family that has contributed to the program. Sharing your password will result in the removal of your internet access and the loss of your donation.
- Proper internet etiquette should be observed. If you wouldn't do it at home, you shouldn't do it at the lake.
- All internet usage is logged by user and device ID. Any abuse will result in removal of your internet access and the loss of your donation.
- Devices connected to the Lake Lenape Wi-Fi should have active and up to date virus software installed.
- Your device's Operating System should be properly patched and maintained in order to protect others that are also utilizing the Wi-Fi service. Access will be removed and you will lose your donation if your device is found to have harmful or malicious software. Access can be reinstated once your device is determined to be no longer a threat.
- Lake Lenape association reserves the right to comply with law enforcement in the event of an investigation of illegal internet activities connected with your internet activity.

Restrictions:

Abuse of the services will result in the removal of internet access and loss of your donation. Several services, protocols and activities will be blocked in order to protect the Lake Association and its members

List of Banned services and protocols include but are not limited to:

- Downloading Torrents (in general)
- SMTP (Port 25 outbound)

List of Banned Web Sites (by category):

- Websites and services categorized as "Sex"
- Websites and categorized as "Gambling"
- Websites and categorized as "Violence"
- Websites and categorized as "Hacking, Cracking or software Pirating"

Hard wired connections are not allowed and cannot be provided.

Router firewall rules cannot be added or modified for any device or service.
