

## Lake Lenape Association Spring General Membership Meeting May 5, 2012 Minutes

**Minutes-** Minutes from the April 10, 2012 were accepted as received via email by all attending board members.

**Treasury Report-** C. Wallis stated that year to date we are down 7 members. Regular membership is down 12, but senior membership is up 8 memberships. Sponsored Membership stands at 21 memberships. Overall we are down a little from last year.

**Lifeguards-** Lifeguards are in place and there will be a short meeting on May 15, 2012 at 7pm to get to know the lifeguards.
